

Synchron Duality Strings comprises **two string ensembles** that were recorded at once, performing in separate rooms at Synchron Stage Vienna. The large ensemble played in the famous main hall, Stage A, delivering a full, more symphonic sound. The smaller ensemble was recorded in the relatively dry Stage B to provide a transparent and clear tonality that adds a certain polish when blended with the larger group.



Both ensembles played simultaneously, performing all articulations in perfect sync. Together they deliver a magnificent sound with unprecedented flexibility and countless expressive possibilities, from intimate intensity to passionate power, and everything in between – all in one easy to use player instance.

Would you like the first violins to sound crispier in your arrangement, without losing their breadth and depth? **Just raise the faders and balance the sound** of your 14 violin players in Stage A with the 8 violins from Stage B!
